Feast of the Epiphany – January 6th

Epiphany, or Three Kings' Day, is observed on January 6. It is one of the three most important days, along with Christmas and Easter. At Epiphany, the Church celebrates the manifestation of the Son of God as the Savior and Messiah. At Epiphany we recall the visit of the Magi to the newborn Jesus: "And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh." (Matthew 2:9–12)
