Summer Reading Program—Beginning on June 13, register for the reading program online and log your reading minutes and activities on the Elm Grove Library Beanstack site (elmgrovelibrary.beanstack.org) or with the Beanstack app. If you participated last year, you don't need to create a new account. Just log into your existing account and select the Oceans of Possibilities challenge! When you log your reading and activities, you will receive coupons and drawing slips for the end of summer drawing. (A paper reading log will also be available if preferred.)



Family Story Times—Bring a blanket to spread on the grass for outdoor story time at **10:30 a.m. on Fridays!** Content will generally be for children 3-4 years old but all are welcome to participate in stories, songs and rhymes. If weather is wet or cold, story time will move inside.

Teen Volunteers will be needed to help with programs this summer. Volunteers should be at least 12 years old by August 2022.
