Greetings:

State law requires districts to administer the state-funded ACT to all juniors in the spring of that school year. Delaware Area Career Center will be testing all **full day** juniors at both campuses on **February 20, 2019** free of charge. The state administration of the ACT will include the primary subject areas in reading, English, mathematics and science. It is imperative that all full day junior students, who are not testing with accommodations, be present on February 20<sup>th</sup>. Testing will begin at 8:00 AM and conclude at 12:15 PM. Students will be provided a school lunch after administration and then resume their normal school day. The make-up day for testing is **March 12, 2019**.

Students testing with accommodations will be testing **February 21<sup>st</sup> - February 26<sup>th</sup>** excluding the weekend. One section of ACT will be given per school day starting at 8:00 AM. It is also important that students show up for testing on those designated four days as the sections of the test have to be administered in sequential order. Absences will only further delay learning within the morning CTE Programs. Case managers will inform students of the accommodations that have been approved by ACT.

DACC will be providing test preparation sessions to all full day juniors leading up to testing day(s).

Important Information:

- Students must present a valid driver's license, school ID or state ID to be admitted into ACT Testing. DACC can assist with the creation of a new school ID.
- All students will be provided with a Texas Instrument 30 Calculator for the math section. Students are permitted to also bring their own calculators. Please see the link below for acceptable calculators.
