NATIONAL OVERVIEW

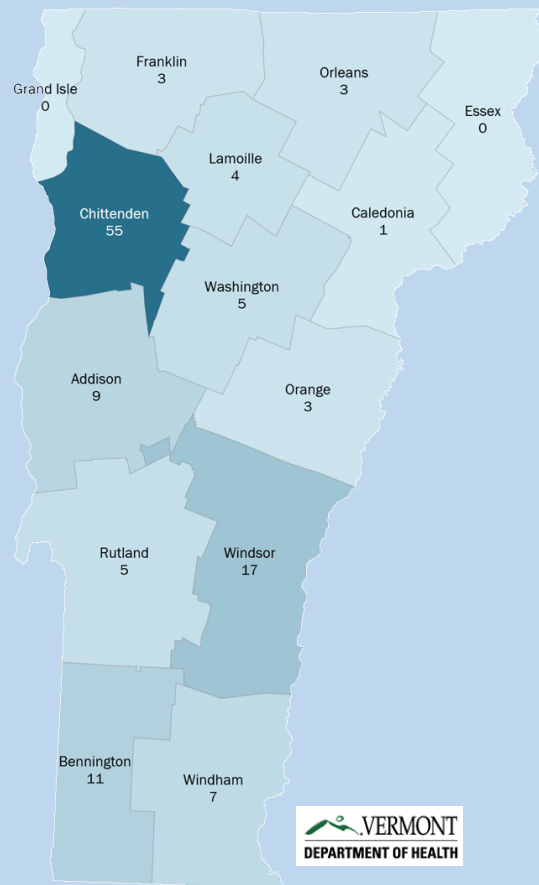
DHS National Operations Center (NOC):

As of 1700 ET 24 Mar, FEMA reported **44,467** (+11,177) COVID-19 U.S. cases and **550** (+150) domestic fatalities. WHO/FEMA reported **377,801** (+40,989) confirmed cases and **16,441** (+3,567) fatalities worldwide

To ensure consistency in federal-level reporting of case numbers, DHS NOC now uses FEMA/HHS sourcing .
