We have 63 well water testing kits for residents in Buckingham, Fluvanna, and around Scottsville.

We are looking for:

- Areas that may have lead and other contaminants in their drinking water that could adversely affect the health of their families
- Households that have not had their well water tested in the past five years
- Households that are unable to pay the \$60 testing fee

How it works:

- Test kits are available at the Town of Scottsville office
- They are on a first come, first serve basis
- Call 434-987-9267 to reserve
- The test must be done on Wednesday, October 28
- It needs to be delivered to the Town of Scottsville office between 8:30 and 10:00 on Wednesday, October 28

How to test:

- There are specific instructions in the kit
- It is important to fill the bottles first thing in the morning
- Please fill out all paperwork

This test is part of a research project with the Virginia Cooperative Extension and UVAs iThrive program. The data will be analyzed by UVA and will enable HEARR (Health Equity and Access in Rural Regions) to identify potential health disparities in our region.
