

As we get closer to the start of the 25-26 school year here is some information to keep in mind as you plan.

Parking Passes - At the recommendation of student leadership, we are going to assigned parking spaces in our back lot. Your parking pass can be purchased on <u>BOUND</u> under the "tickets" tab, on a first come first serve basis. On 8 AM on your assigned day, a bound link will be sent, along with a passcode, to **students' emails**. The following grades will receive the link and code on the dates below.

- 12th Grade Friday, August 15th, 8 AM
- 11th Grade Monday, August 18th, 8 AM
- 10th Grade Tuesday, August 19th, 8 AM
- 9th/8th Grade Wednesday August 20th, 8 AM

The price for a pass is \$60. When the back lot is completely filled, remaining students will need to purchase a spot in the front lot, via the ticketing tab on bound. The front lot will not be assigned parking and will be on a first come first serve basis each day. All students who drive will need a parking pass. Students who park on school grounds without a pass will receive disciplinary action, up to not being able to park on school grounds at all. Dress Code - Our dress code was updated for the upcoming school year last March. We expect everyone to meet expectations on the first day. You can review the changes <u>here</u>.

Open House - Our open house is scheduled for Thursday August 21st. On that day students will get their picture taken, be able to meet their teachers, pick up their purchased parking passes, as well as meet with counselors to make any needed schedule changes. This year we are asking that students <u>wear a dress code polo for their pictures</u>. We will have some available to wear in the gym. To ensure that the fit and look is to your liking, please bring one of your own. Below is the schedule for August 21st.

12th: 8:30-9:00 11th: 9:00-9:30 10th: 9:30-10:00 9th: 10:00-10:30 8th: 10:30-11:00

7th: 1:00-1:30 (orientation starts at 1:30)

*New students in grades 8-12 do not have to follow the schedule as they have orientation at 9:00

A master schedule of classes will be sent to student emails at that time so that students can look through potential changes that they would like to make. Students may reach out to their counselor the next week to make any needed changes.
