

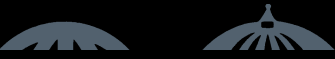

We would like to personally invite you, your family, and your friends to join us on this pilgrimage to the Sites and Shrines of France! Our journey begins in Annecy, following in the Footsteps of St. Francis de Sales, and Ars with its Shrine of St. John Vianney, the "Cure of Ars" and patron saint of parish priests. Visit Paray-le-Monial, where Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the Visitation Convent. Continue to Nevers to visit St. Gildard's Convent and pray before the uncorrupted body of St. Bernadette, and Chartres to visit Our Lady of Chartres Cathedral, which has been a major pilgrimage site for centuries, depicting more than five thousand images in its sculpture works and stained-glass windows.

Our pilgrimage will take us to Normandy's famous landing beaches, where we will pay our respects to the soldiers who lost their lives liberating France from the Nazi stronghold, and Lisieux, where we'll visit the family home of St. Thérèse. Finally we'll arrive in Paris, the "City of Light," and see the highlights of the city, including Notre Dame Cathedral and Sainte Chapelle. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal, where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré, tour the beautiful Sacré Coeur Basilica, and enjoy a dinner cruise on the Seine River, passing the illuminated monuments of Paris.

Our pilgrimage concludes in Lourdes, one of the world's most popular destinations for pilgrims. We will pray in the grotto where the Blessed Mother appeared to Bernadette Soubirous and revealed herself as "the Immaculate Conception." We invite you to bring all of your intentions to Mary, Mother of our earthly pilgrimage. We hope you will join us!

DAY 1 Monday, October 5: Depart USA

Depart St. Margaret Mary Church parking lot via private coach for Newark Liberty International Airport. Upon arrival, check-in for our flight to Geneva, via London. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Tuesday, October 6: Arrive in Geneva | Annecy

Late morning, arrive at Geneva Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager outside Customs. Board our private tour bus and we will be on our way to Annecy, magnificently situated on Lake Annecy (the Blue Lake) in the heart of the Savoy Alps. St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal founded the Congregation of the Visitation at Annecy in 1610. Independent lunch.

We'll begin our walking tour in the footsteps of St. Francis de Sales. We will visit the Church of St. Francis de Sales (the first Visitation Monastery), the Gallery House (where the Visitation Order began), the famous statue of St. Francis de Sales in the center of town, the Cathedral of St. Pierre (where Francis was ordained a priest and officiated as a bishop), Madame de Charmoisy's House (influential in the writing of the *Introduction of the Devout Life*), the House of President Antoine Favre, and the places where the miracles attributed to St. Francis de Sales took place. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Visitation.** After Mass, we'll check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Annecy.

DAY 3 Wednesday, October 7: Annecy | Ars | Paray-le-Monial

Our Lady of the Rosary

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Annecy and travel to Ars (45-minute bus ride). Upon arrival we'll visit the Shrine of St. John Vianney, the "Cure of Ars" and patron saint of parish priests. After our visit we'll continue to Paray-le-Monial. Independent lunch.

We'll explore Paray-le-Monial, where Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the Visitation Convent. From here, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus spread throughout the world. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Apparition in Paray-le-Monial.** Visit the great medieval church, built as the official basilica to commemorate the apparitions. After our visit we'll check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Paray-le-Monial.

DAY 4 Thursday, October 8: Nevers | Chartres

Breakfast at our hotel. After an early breakfast, we'll continue to Nevers to visit St. Gildard's Convent and pray beside the intact body of Bernadette Soubirous in the main chapel of the sanctuary. At the conclusion of the eighteen apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes, St. Bernadette lived for 12 years as a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine in Nevers.** Independent lunch.

We'll leave Nevers for Chartres (3.5-hour bus ride). The cathedral spires of Chartres can be seen from miles away, seeming to rise out of the wheat fields of the Beauce Plains. Check-in at our hotel upon arrival.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Chartres.

DAY 5 Friday, October 9: Chartres | Normandy Landing Beaches | Lisieux

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll visit Notre Dame Cathedral of Chartres, which boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture and houses the Sancta Camisia, a tunic that tradition says belonged to the Blessed Virgin Mary. After our visit, we'll continue to Normandy to visit the Landing Beaches (4-hour bus ride). Independent lunch.

Our first stop will be Utah Beach to see the American Memorial that commemorates the achievements of U.S. VII Corps forces that fought in the liberation of the Cotentin Peninsula from June 6 to July 1, 1944. The monument overlooks the sand dunes of this historic site. Continue to visit Omaha Beach to see the U.S. Monument, followed by a visit to the Normandy American Cemetery in Colleville-sur-Mer. Experience the Flag Retreat Ceremony. Continue to visit and **celebrate Mass at Sainte-Mere-Eglise Church.** The most humbling site is the stained-glass window that depicts two American Paratroopers descending during D-Day. Then, continue to Pont-l'Évêque for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Pont-l'Évêque.

DAY 6 Saturday, October 10: Lisieux | Paris

Breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with a visit to the Basilica of St. Thérèse in Lisieux, where we will **celebrate Mass in the Crypt Chapel.** After Mass, we'll have a

guided visit of the Basilica of St. Thérèse and the Crypt, where the bodies of Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, the parents of Saint Thérèse, are buried. Our next visit will be "Les Buissonnets," the family home of St. Thérèse in Lisieux. Thérèse spent eleven years of her life there until she entered the Carmelite convent at the age of 15. Continue to the Carmel of Lisieux, where St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus and of the Holy Face lived her life as a Carmelite nun from 1888 until her death in 1897. The convent remains a place of silence, prayer, and life of the Carmelite community. Pilgrims may visit the chapel, the Shrine of Thérèse that contains her relics, the memorial located in the courtyard of the chapel, and the bookstore.

Independent lunch in Lisieux.

Early afternoon, we'll leave Lisieux for Paris, the "City of Light" (3-hour bus ride). Upon arrival in Paris, we'll have an orientation tour to experience the remarkable sights of this magnificent and romantic city on the Seine. We'll see the Eiffel Tower, Champs Élysées, Arc de Triomphe, Place de la Concorde, Opéra, Place de la Bastille, and Place des Vosges, the oldest planned square in Paris. Check-in at our hotel. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Paris.

DAY 7 Sunday, October 11: Pilgrim Churches of Paris | Seine River Cruise

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day at Rue de Bac. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal.** After Mass, there will be time to venerate and pray at the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Labouré. This chapel is where the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared to St. Catherine Labouré (1806-1876) from July to December of 1830 and gave the world a medal on which the words, "O Mary, conceived without sin pray for us who have recourse to thee," are inscribed. Continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent DePaul, where his saintly remains are preserved and venerated. Next, we'll visit Ile de la Cité, where we will **visit the cathedral, Notre Dame de Paris**, a jewel of gothic arts and massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows that will take your breath away. In the 17th century, after 23 years of marriage and no children, King Louis XIII consecrated France to the Virgin Mary in thanks for the birth of his son, the famous Louis XIV. Continue to visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis IX. Discover its unique stained-glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the Heavenly Jerusalem. Sainte Chapelle (Holy Chapel) is a real treasure hidden on the Island of the Ile de la Cité in the center of Paris. It was built as a royal eccrine to receive the holy relics of the Crown of Thorns, acquired by French King Louis IX. Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to explore Paris on your own.

This evening, enjoy a special dinner cruise aboard the famous Parisian Bateaux Mouches. Enjoy illuminated views of the most beautiful sites of Paris from the Seine! Overnight at our hotel in Paris.

DAY 8 Monday, October 12: Paris | Lourdes

After an early breakfast at our hotel, we'll be transferred to Paris CDG Airport for our continuing flight to Lourdes. Late morning we'll arrive at Lourdes Airport. Claim our luggage and board our bus to Lourdes (40-minute bus ride).

Independent lunch upon arrival in Lourdes.

When we arrive in Lourdes, we'll have a brief orientation tour of the sanctuary domain, including the Basilica of St. Pius X, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, the Crypt, and the Grotto.

Celebrate Mass in one of the sanctuary chapels.

Check-in and get settled in at our hotel. Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

At 9:00 p.m., participate in praying the Rosary in the Chapel of the Apparitions, followed by a Candlelight Procession honoring the Mother of God.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

DAY 9 Tuesday, October 13: Lourdes Sanctuary | Walking Tour of Lourdes

Breakfast at our hotel. **Celebrate Mass at the Grotto** (subject to confirmation. *Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.*)

This morning we'll embark on a walking tour of Lourdes and visit places associated with the life of young Bernadette. The places include the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to enjoy personal time at the sanctuary.

Sanctuary celebrations you may participate in:

Baths 9:00 a.m.-11:30 a.m. & 2:00 p.m.-4:30 p.m.

It is no longer possible to bathe completely. However, members of the hospitality staff and volunteers are available to welcome you to the baths and accompany you to perform the "Water Gesture."

Rosary at the Grotto at 3:00 p.m.

Eucharistic Procession at 5:00 p.m.

The Chapel of Reconciliation is open daily.

Dinner at the hotel restaurant.

At 9:00 p.m., join the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary, and singing of hymns to honor Our Lady.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Lourdes.

DAY 10 Wednesday, October 14: Return to the USA

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to Toulouse Airport for our return flight to the USA. Arrive in Newark on the same day. Our private coach and driver will be waiting to take us back to St. Margaret Mary Church.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. **Peter's Way Tours (PWT)** reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: The \$500.00 deposit is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Newark. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$4,245.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,295.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus seven (7) dinners, including a special dinner cruise on the Seine River aboard the famous Parisian Bateaux Mouches. All dinners include a glass of wine and mineral water.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for

local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping. **(For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred).**
