



# Safety Protocols

**for everyone worshipping, visiting, or working at St. Paul's:**

1. Wash and/or sanitize your hands frequently.
2. Anyone who has not been vaccinated or is uncomfortable around others is encouraged to take precautions -
  - A properly worn mask, covering both the mouth and nose, should be worn at all times.
  - Keep at least six feet of distance from anyone not living in your household.
3. Do not come to the campus if you are ill, have a fever, or if you suspect or know that you have COVID-19.
4. For Sunday Services -
  - **Socially distanced seating** is available by reservation. Please arrive by 9:45am to get seated in this special section. *To make a reservation, click the link in your Saturday Enews or contact the church office (805 643-5033 or office@saintpaulsventura.org) by Noon on Thursday for the following Sunday's service).*
  - **Open seating** is available for those who no longer need to practice social distancing according to the CDC guidelines. No reservation is required. Be sure to arrive by 10am to get seated and ready for the service which begins at 10:15am.
