We are here to give help and inform our seniors who have not received their vaccine yet

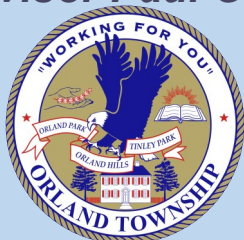
## VACCINE AVAILABILITY

The supply of vaccines is currently very limited, appointments will be added on an ongoing basis as more vaccines are allocated to providers.

There is about 375,000 people aged 65 and over who are 1B eligible throughout Cook County.

Cook County is overseeing the distribution of the vaccine. The National Guard is administering the vaccine at multiple supersites throughout the county.

## SCHEDULING

You must sign up before you can schedule your vaccine.

Sign up for Cook County's Covid-19 Community Vaccination Program at [vaccine.cookcountyil.gov](https://vaccine.cookcountyil.gov) or call the Cook County Vaccine Hotline 833-308-1988.

If you do not have a computer, email, or cell phone, ask someone you trust such as a family member or friend to help you sign up online.

Appointments may not be available right away, due to the limited vaccine availability. 

More vaccines are scheduled to be delivered each week at vaccination sites.
