Karen also reported that the OMC credit card has been hacked. The person bought car parts in Michigan. It has been reported and we will be reimbursed for the total amount.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS –**

## **SHOW REPORT - Karen Breckenridge**

The Belt Buckles have been ordered. We will be listed in the Saddle Horse Report. We have approval from the AHSA, AMHA, USEF, Oregon Dressage and UPHA for the OMC Show. The grant application was sent to AMHA and has been accepted. We don't know yet if we will receive anything. The Medals will roll over from last year. Julie Nygaard has accepted the job of putting together the sponsor baskets. Each Board member is asked to donate one or two bottles of wine to fill 13-15 baskets. Karen has talked to 15 professional trainers about running ads for the Professional Directory that goes in the back of the Prize list; so far 3 trainers have donated \$300 in ads. The Professional Directory ads pay for the printing and mailing of the premium booklet. In 2019 we had \$20,000. in sponsors for our classes and this year so far we have \$2600 committed. Talk to horse related businesses that you patronize; Vets, horse shoers, feed stores, tack stores, etc... We need as many sponsors as we can get. We anticipate it will be harder this year.

Judges update- We now have all of our judges for the show. *Renee Johnson*, a 2020 Morgan Grand National judge has said yes. Her job will be English, Western, Classical and Driving Dressage. Working Western judge will be *Peggy Bond-Heath* and the main judge will be *Ron Bartholomew*.

#### **HI-POINT- Erin Silver**

No 'new' news to report except that there will be a facebook blast on how to sign up and encouraging everyone to sign up for our end of the year hi-point awards. We also need the revised program which will include something for virtual shows to be available to put into the Stable Sheet newsletter in March.

Karen B. has booked the Dye House in Salem for the awards Banquet. It was suggested to move the time up 1 hour to accommodate members that drive a longer distance. Time frame from 12:00 to 4:00. Previous time was 1:00- 5:00.

## **EDUCATION/SPRING CLINIC – Erin Silver**

There was a discussion about having a virtual clipping clinic in April. Sara Breyman has graciously volunteered to do the Zoom clinic for that subject. Sara and Erin will get together to talk it over and get some plans in motion.

There was also a discussion about possibly having a Social weekend in Stub Stewart horse park or Silver Creek Falls this July. This would be a trail ride for MHAO members. Doana Anderson and Erin will work on this idea. Nothing was decided.

Our bylaws state that we need to have General Membership meeting before April 30<sup>th</sup> each year. In years past we have combined it with our Educational clinic. There was discussion about having the Clipping, Auction and Membership meeting all together or separate. Gay and Kathy will figure this out and report back to the Board.

#### **YOUTH COMMITTEE – Diane Pixlee & Grace Martin**

The Virtual Shows are a go! There will be 3 shows this year starting with the February Show. The patterns will go out on February 15th and they need to be turned in by February 26th. It will cost \$20.00 per class and there are 4 classes to enter; Showmanship, Saddleseat, Huntseat and Western. The youth will receive feedback on different parts of their patterns so they can improve for the next show. Diane has talked to trainers and let them know that this is open to any youth that rides a Morgan. You do not need to be an MHAO member but this may encourage them to join. Grace mentioned that she joined because it was \$15.00 if you were a member of MHAO and \$20.00 if non-member. Great incentive to increase our membership. There will be 4 different age groups: 9 & under that will be strictly walk-trot with easy patterns, 10-13, 14-17 and 18-21. There will be criteria as to how the videographer makes the tapes; such as where to stand, how far away, etc... Diane plans to have ribbons for each class and a hipoint at the end of the series, possibly gift cards. Nancy Eidam suggested we do a 'certificate of accomplishment' for all. She found a certificate in some old boxes, she was going through, and enjoyed the memory of earning it. It's important to feel accomplished and to be able to hang something on the wall or keep in a notebook. Diane and the board liked this idea and agreed. Nancy also thought a good idea would be to do a cover letter, sign ups and printed patterns to send out to potential entrants. Diane thanked Sara Breyman for the pattern help. The judge has been lined up and is Todd Trushel. He will review the video patterns and write comments for each entrant. The question was asked how much to

pay the judge? This could depend on the total number of entrants. Karen will email Nancy Harvey to ask the going rate for Virtual show judges and get back to Diane. Gay and Diane will get together to send out a special edition of the Stable Sheet and to get out on the club Facebook page. Diane & Grace will get it out on Instagram, the Youth Facebook page, and other Facebook pages. Grace will also write it up in the Youth Newsletter.

## STALLION AUCTION - Gay Adams

The nominations for Stallions will remain open through February. There are 31 Stallions signed up so far. They will be featured in the February Stable Sheet. The Morgan Horse Magazine comes out in April with an Advertisement about our MHAO Auction. Online bidding is in place and bidders without online access can call in their bids to Gay. The Auction will close on April 17<sup>th</sup> at 3pm PDT.

## **FUTURITY - Gay Adams**

There are currently 32 horses signed up for the Futurity. Participants must be a member of MHAO to participate, and this program brings in 4-6 new members each year. The overall number enrolled is down due to the retirement of a number of breeders. This year only we will add 3 year old Halter classes along with a Sweepstakes Class; and 5 yr old performance classes. This is due to not having Futurity classes in 2020. There will also be a futurity high point award for 5 yr olds as well as 4 yr olds.

Futurity renewals will go out the end of February or first of March.
