Committee Reports:

OMC Show Committee:

Karen: We have finished the prizelist and it is on the MHAO website. Everything is coming together as far as the awards, coolers and ribbons to come. Working on the progressive dinner, etc. A question was asked about putting out a press release for the show. Gay asked if anyone would like to put something out, that they pass it by her first so we can make sure it doesn't make problems for us down the road.

Hi Point Committee:

Erin: Nothing new to report.

Spring Clinic and Fall Awards Banquet:

Patricia: Welcome to the Spring Clinic. Patricia has implored everyone to fill out the surveys of what everyone would like to see for future Spring Clinics. Different discussions were held for various venues and food options for the Fall banquet. Erin suggested a taco bar. Tammy's issue with the venues that she has encountered has been that there is a two-hour maximum, which would not be long enough for our meetings. We need to decide on a venue soon or we won't be able to get one.

Youth Committee:

Kyndle and Camryn: Almost done with the youth newsletter. There are a few technical details they are working on. This will be finished and published next week.

Stallion Auction Committee:

Gay: Auction is open until April 20th at 3:00 p.m. it is all online. We have 27 stallions currently offered.

Futurity Committee:

Gay: We don't have big money in the futurity like they do back East. All of our futurity classes have prize money. We offer halter classes from 0-2 years old. Those who place first or second in their halter class can move on to their associated sweepstakes class. There are two halter divisions. One section that has sport-type horses, so sport & Western: and then a traditional section. Performance classes are available for 2-4 yr olds. We have a driving class for 2 year olds and a wide array of performance classes for 3-4 year olds. The proceeds from the stallion auction provide our futurity prize money.

Promotion:

Erin: Ordered a new 2X10' banner for AgFest. Will probably take LittleWood Chinook again. All brochures, stickers, tattoos, coloring sheets, etc. will be taken and put together with new swag bags. All within budget. We received a \$1,500 grant from AMHA that will allow us to do more than last year. AgFest is at the Salem Fairgrounds April 27-28.

We will have a presence at the Oregon State Fair, and Erin will again head up the "Battle of the Breeds" which Morgans have won for the last three years.

Membership Committee:

Gay: If you haven't sent your membership dues in, please do so right away. We don't have an official membership chair yet. We need someone who knows Microsoft Access. We don't have any Board Members that currently have knowledge of that program. We can have a volunteer to take this position, but they must be connected with us and attend Board meetings. If anyone is interested, please let Gay know.
