

Shotgun News!

We now have a full 5 stand, with 2 new machines which gives us a total of 8, one of them being a "Midi" which is smaller and faster! One is a "Teal" that means it's straight up and straight down! If you have not shot it, come try it' it's a lot of fun! We also added 2 "Midi's" on the sporting clays course.

On a different note, if you are shooting any of the shotgun sports please fill out the envelope with your name/names and how many rounds you shot and \$ amounts. We're trying to keep records of how many rounds of skeet, trap, SC, and 5 stand are being shot for future development.

For example, we find money, but no envelope. We see members sign in for sporting clays, no dollar amounts and no envelope with their name on it. So all we can assume is they shot but did not pay or the cash in the box might have been theirs or someone else's.???

The only way we can replenish our clays is if everyone pays for what they shoot.

As a reminder on the cost of shooting shotgun sports.

Skeet- \$3.00 per round = 1 box = 25 shells shot

Trap- \$3.00 per round = 1 box = 25 shells shot

Sporting Clays- \$5.00 per box = 25 shells shot. Example: you shoot all 10 stations that = 100 shots = 4 boxes= \$20.00

5 Stand- \$5.00 per round = 1 box = 25 shells shot.

The better our shotgun sports get, the more we have to do to keep it up. Keep in mind we are all volunteers and we need everyone's help to keep this awesome project going.
