And, you'll learn Four Myths about communication that organizations (churches too) often swallow whole.

Family Systems is **not a gimmick or a quick fix**. It is not a way to banish conflict. It is not a way to grow your church larger. It is a way "doing church" which involves seeing and acting responsibly.

The problem of communication:

Whales don't have libraries and chimps haven't invented telephones. Complex language and literacy are unique attributes of humanity. These abilities have allowed us to expand and develop civilizations. Yet even using these powerful tools we often fail to communicate.

Explaining Four Myths about communication.

- Changing any system begins with the self.
- Successful communication requires honesty.
