We are very thankful for her ongoing support!





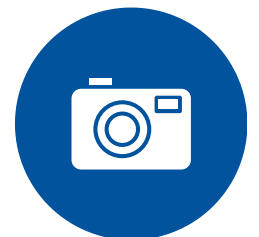

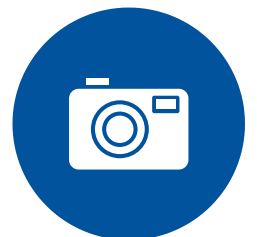
ANNUAL COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD BREAKFAST VIP MEET & GREET

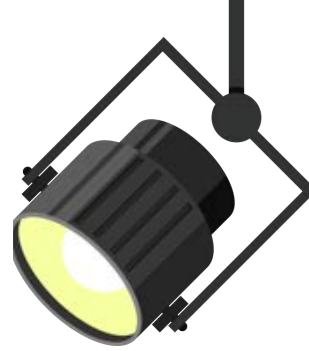
