Behind The Lens

CARRIE BRADBURN CAPEHART PHOTOGRAPHY

When you come across Carrie Bradburn, she's usually in motion, eyes behind the camera, focused on getting the perfect shot.

On April 24, 2023, Carrie let *us* record *her story* for *The Civic* and for a future feature on PBTV. She answered the big question about how she became the "go to" photographer on Palm Beach, over the last thirty years.

It all started in 1991, when the restaurant Carrie was working for was sold and she was out of a job. At the same time, a good friend of renowned Palm Beach photographer Lucien Capehart was looking for an assistant. Carrie was hired, and the rest, as they say, is history. She started out holding a camera light, taking names at events, running film to the lab, and answering phones.



Over the years, her role at Capehart would grow. Carrie says, "Lucien was like a father to me. I started working for him right after my father died. He walked me down the isle at my wedding. He was there for all four of my kids' births. It's kind of like he was my dad."

Carrie handled the business side of Capehart, and also learned the art of photography from Lucien.

CARRIE HAS A GOOD MEMORY

Carrie is a walking encyclopedia of who's who on the Island. "Lucien taught me at the very beginning to learn somebody's name when you greet them. It makes a difference when you greet them in front of the camera."

Carrie also learned to be considerate of people's privacy. She does not disclose details about people and says, "at the end of the day, it's not worth it."

When Lucien passed away in 2012, Carrie took the helm. She says, "Lucien died 12 years ago, and he left the company to me. So I was very fortunate in that regard."



Capehart is already booked every weekend in February 2024. She handles bookings on a "first come, first serve basis."

"I enjoy my summers. I look forward to **May 1st** when I close my office on Fridays and take time off to be with my children and my family."
