Dear El Sol Academy Families,

I hope you are well and you and your family are staying safe.

You probably have heard that the U.S Supreme Court has indicated that, at least for the time being, the government must keep in place the DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) program. This is good news for young people who want to renew their DACA eligibility and it could be good news for young persons who want to apply for DACA status for the first time. I say “could” because the government has not yet begun to process new applications. Many lawyers believe it will start accepting NEW- first time applications soon.

If you have members of your family now covered by DACA and they need to renew status in the DACA program, **they can do so now by applying for renewal through USCIS.**

According to lawyers advising the El Sol Foundation and El Sol Academy, first time applicants should begin to prepare their applications now so that if and when new applications will be accepted by USCIS, they will be able to send in all the paperwork quickly.

The Foundation has and is now working with a group of lawyers who can and will advise your DACA family members and eligible children concerning DACA renewal and first-time application procedures and needed documentation. I will help you secure experienced legal assistance at no cost to you or members of your family.
