Core Services

FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES/CASE MANAGEMENT

Provides support, guidance, information and case management for up to 3 months to families who are experiencing difficult situations.

INFORMATION AND REFERRALS

Assistance in locating resources such as healthcare, legal aid, housing, educational classes, food, tutoring and immigration services.

COUNSELING

Individual and family counseling for families who are part of the case management (FSA) at the FRC and are uninsured.

PARENTING CLASSES

6 week virtual series classes that provide social support, enhance coping skills, improve knowledge of child development, improve knowledge of appropriate & effective discipline. In collaboration with Olive Crest. Next cycle will start on Wednesday July 14, 2021 from 5pm-7pm. Via Zoom. Class will be held in Spanish.

PERSONAL EMPOWERMENT CLASSES (PEP)
