

What is Technology Center of DuPage?

TCD is your high school elective for advanced career and technical education, serving juniors and seniors attending school in DuPage County and Lyons Township.

Hands-on learning and college credit available!

- 19 in-depth programs (see list below or www.tcdupage.org).
- Preparation for post-secondary education and career entry.
- Project-based learning, work-based experiences.
- Both high school and transferable college credit possible.
- Industry certifications in most programs.
- Information about scholarships – we'll even help you apply!

How does it work and what does it cost?

- Programs are offered two hours a day, Monday-Friday, junior or senior year or both.
- Students enroll through their high school counseling department.
- TCD programs take place at the campus in Addison or Naperville (depending on your school location and program choice)..
- Bus transportation is provided by your school district.
- No tuition: TCD is an elective part of your high school's curriculum.
- Pay a modest flat fee for books and supplies; see www.tcdupage.org for any additional program-related costs.
