- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign your FAFSA electronically (this can be created at the time of application or before the workshop by going to fsaid.gov)
- List of colleges you would like to attend

What is College Changes Everything Month?

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the application used to apply for federal and some state and institutional student aid, becomes available on October 1 of the calendar year **before** the student plans to attend college. Because students begin in October to complete their FAFSAs at the same time they are completing their college applications, the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) launched College Changes Everything® (CCE) Month. During CCE Month, ISAC, high schools and community partners across the state offer support for both college application activities and FAFSA completion.
