

Title: AP English Orientation Cost: \$27

The purpose of the AP English Orientation is for Advanced Placement students to become familiar with reading, writing, and analytical thinking skills expected in an AP English class. AP English Language and Composition (junior year) and AP English Literature and Composition (senior year) will initially meet in a large group and then break into workshops led by AP English teachers from Lake Park. Students will become familiar with the respective AP Language and Literature tests. Teachers will outline and model expectations for summer reading assignments. Title: Introduction to Engineering Communication & Concepts

Title: AP Human Geography
