NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida recognizes the month of October, as




in the state of Florida and remind its citizens of the importance of financial planning in framing the prudent financial decisions that help to achieve their goals and dreams.
