The Kentucky Wound Care Excellence Program for Skilled Nursing Facilities was created to help increase the wound care knowledge for nurses working at CMS Certified Facilities in Kentucky. The Vohra Wound Care Course is offered **completely free** for eligible nurses. The scholarships are provided by Kentucky's Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

Eligibility Criteria:

Scholarships sponsored by the Kentucky Wound Care Excellence Program are available to nurses with an active license who work in a CMS Registered Skilled Nursing Facility within the state of Kentucky.

Approval of eligibility criteria required. Verified applicants must complete the program within 60 days or risk forfeiting scholarship. The numbers of scholarships is limited and available on a first come, first serve basis.

Exclusion Criteria:

Nurses working in the following facilities are not eligible to receive scholarships through this program:

1. Special Focus Facilities
2. Facilities with Outstanding Civil Money Penalty Payment
3. Facilities in bankruptcy or receivership
