Course Description:

The Methods of Instruction course prepares the participant to teach the 75 hour Medicaid Nurse Aide Course. The focus of the course is directed toward teaching the adult learner in the classroom, nursing laboratory, and clinical settings.

Eligibility for enrollment: BSN prepared nurses with long term experience. *This course is not valid for KCTCS employees or high school/ secondary instructors. KCTCS employees and high school/ secondary instructors require additional training that will not be offered in this course.*

Learner Outcomes: Learners will be able to teach principles of providing nursing aide care

Objectives: Upon completion of this MOI course, the participant will be

- organize the course of study for nurse aides,
- develop a lesson plan,
- present a lesson,
- perform demonstration of psychomotor skill,
- organize and manage the learning environment,
- meet the needs of the individual learner,
- utilize instructional aids, and
- evaluate student performance

She taught in associate degree nursing programs from 1972-1979, where she taught the aging process and took students to provide care in the long term care setting.
