

Why was the OASIS revised again???

The main reasons for revising OASIS are to increase standardization across post-acute care (**PAC**) settings to improve outcomes, provide access to longitudinal data to facilitate coordinated care, enable comparable data and quality across PAC settings, improve hospital discharge planning and aide in research.

What is SPADEs? Standardized Patient Assessment Data Elements are questions and response options that are identical in all PAC assessment instruments where identical standards and definitions apply.
