Most days, The Gardens at Elm Bank are open hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. New this season, the gardens will remain open into the evening every Wednesday. They will be open until 8 p.m. on Wednesdays in June and July, and until 7:30 p.m. on Wednesdays in August. Visitors of all ages may enjoy the gardens at this magical time of day. Regular garden admission applies: adults \$10; members and children 12 and under free. The gardens are closed on Mondays.

Additionally, all seniors 62+ may enter The Gardens at Elm Bank on Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. for the discounted admission of \$8.
