



DETOUR JUNE 5, 2019

Access to The Gardens at Elm Bank will be adjusted today as access to our main entrance on Washington Street (Route 16) is currently closed.

Turtle Lane is unpaved and unmarked, and we ask that you proceed slowly. The entrance to Turtle Lane is flanked by two large, white columns at the intersection of Main Street, Dover Road, and Charles River Street in Natick. Where Turtle Lane comes to a fork, drive to the left which will lead you to Massachusetts Horticultural Society and The Gardens at Elm Bank.

During detour, Turtle Lane is the only access to our property. Unofficial signage indicating that the road is private, that the public is not permitted, and the road is only for emergency use does not reflect the State Legislature's "No Restrictions" designation.

The detour is for today only. When detour is complete, all vehicles should enter The Gardens at Elm Bank at our 900 Washington St. entrance from Route 16.
