



Greetings Students and Parents/Guardians:

We hope that you are enjoying your summer vacation and are preparing to start your student's high school career. Homewood-Flossmoor High School will be providing a New Student Orientation Day on Thursday, August 12th to help students new to campus become acclimated with H-F prior to all students returning to campus. This will be a mandatory attendance day for all Freshmen, Sophomores, and Transfer students.

On this day, students will come to campus and complete a full day of classes. Class will begin at 7:30a.m. for students that have a 1st period class (E-Period). Students that do not have a 1st period class will begin class at 8:31a.m. with 2nd hour. All students will follow their normal schedule of classes and tour the North and South Buildings within their classes. Students will meet teachers, counselors, and other members of the staff available to help them achieve their goals throughout their high school experience. Please have your student bring the following items with them: face mask, Student ID, their schedule, writing utensils, and chromebook.

Lunch will be available for purchase from our food service. Students will need money if their lunch account was not preloaded. To establish a lunch account or to preload funds on to the account, refer to the **Lunch Info** page on the district website under the **Resources** tab. It takes approximately 20 minutes before funds show up on a student's lunch account.

### New Account Systems for Lunches

When students return to school this August, breakfast and lunch will be available to purchase via cash or student ID in both cafeterias. This year our food service company, Quest, will be using new lunch account systems: RevTrak and MySchoolAccount. Students who had funds remaining in the former MySchoolBucks system — and who did not request a refund — have had their remaining balances transferred into RevTrak. To set up your new lunch account for this school year, please follow these steps below as soon as possible:

- **Step 1:** Request your student's unique verification code by emailing [bmatthews@questfms.com](mailto:bmatthews@questfms.com)
- **Step 2:** Set up your RevTrak account to connect students to your login and to add money to the account throughout the school year. [Access RevTrak here.](#)
- **Step 3:** Set up an account with MySchoolAccount to view food service menus, check account balances and see purchases made by your student with their ID throughout the year. [Access MySchoolAccount here.](#)

RevTrak will be the tool you use to add funds to your student's foodservice account via credit card; funds can also be added via cash payments or checks (*made payable to Quest*) brought to the H-F Business Office in the North Building.


## Transportation

Academic and extra-curricular bus routes can be found on the **Bus Information** page on the district website under the **Resources** tab.

For bus riding students, the bus schedule with bus stops reflects the route that your student will ride to school for academic classes. To determine pick-up times, you will gauge the approximate time of pick up at each stop by the order of the stops listed, based on the start time of the route. Please pay attention to the bus route number as it will be the same route that your student will take returning home in the afternoon.

For bus riding students, buses will unload at the South Building, Door 1, then proceed to the North Building Atrium. After school, all buses will load and depart from the South Building Semicircle Drive.

For non-bus riding students, please arrive on campus 15 minutes prior to the start of the student's first assigned class period. Parents/guardians entering from Kedzie Avenue will drop off at Door 12 then exit onto Kedzie Avenue. Parents/guardians entering from Governors Highway will drop off at the Atrium then proceed around North Building to exit onto Governors Highway. All after school pick-up will take place in the South Building parking lot.
