

Travel to Newfoundland with Windham Hill UCC in August 2019

We are going to “the Rock”! Our visit will include three nights in St. John’s, the largest city and capital of the province where we will enjoy music and dance in the Newfie tradition. We hope to see icebergs and puffins, rocky coastline and spectacular National Parks. We will visit Gander with it’s memorials and hear the story of the 38 planes that arrived on September 11th and the hospitality that followed. Our tour will include visits to Twillingate peninsula with its historic fishing outports. All of this, and the time change is one an hour and a half! There are no overnight flights!

Our travel dates are Thursday, August 29th to Friday, September 6th, 2019. We will be flying Air Canada from Boston to St. John’s. The cost of the trip, per person, double occupancy, is \$3500 which includes airfare, hotels, transportation in Newfoundland, a Newfoundlander guide throughout the trip, 8 buffet breakfasts and 3 lunches and 7 dinners including a special evening with entertainment in St. John’s to end the trip, all taxes and airline fuel surcharges as of December 1, 2018, hotel portorage, and entrances to all sites on the itinerary. Sally Colegrove will be the Tour Director for this adventure, with the details of the journey handled by Gate 1 Travel. Travel will be by luxury motor coach. Accommodations will be in all superior first class hotels.
