What is it?

Tele-Stories invites you into creative and engaging conversations from the comfort of your own home with emerging community storytellers. Your storytelling partner will then create a piece of art guided by your conversations.



Who it's for?

Any older adult in Brown County who would like to tap into their creative side and engage in conversation. **There is no previous experience in being creative necessary to participate.**

What should I expect if I sign up?

You'll be paired with senior-level students in a UW-Green Bay Capstone class on storytelling, community, and connections. These students will provide a 30-minute call once a week, for four weeks starting October 17th, and running through the week of November 11th, 2022. The students will guide you in conversation prompts and fun, creative activities over the phone.

- No cost nor materials are needed.
- From the shared conversation, the students will work to create a culminating art piece and share it back with you at the end of the program.

What else should I know?

- Each call is unique; they are completely customized to you
- The calls are scheduled at a time of the week that works for you
- All you need is a telephone - a smartphone or landline is fine!
