



## USTA Southwest - Leagues

USTA Southwest is slowly and safely welcoming tennis players back to USTA programming. This is happening on a case-by-case basis, on local situations and in conjunction with government orders and local health authorities.

Based on Player feedback related to the travel required and player safety, **USTA Leagues in Northern Arizona is electing not to play a 2021 Early Start League (Advancing) this Fall.**

- 'Local' league play will occur in its place – most likely Flagstaff & Prescott locations (would love to add Sedona)
- The full 2021 schedule will be published later this Fall and will attempt to incorporate all advancing league play during the 2021 calendar year (per the USTA SW Sectional's and National's calendars)

  - ❖ Mixed Doubles League
  - ❖ Men's or Women's NTRP Tri-Level Doubles League
- Majority have interest in smaller Teams (play 2 or 3 lines per match) and staggered start times
- Some increased interest in developing as a Captain
- Majority willing to entertain the idea of a team 'draw' or 'draft' – **appreciate the support of true community!!**
