

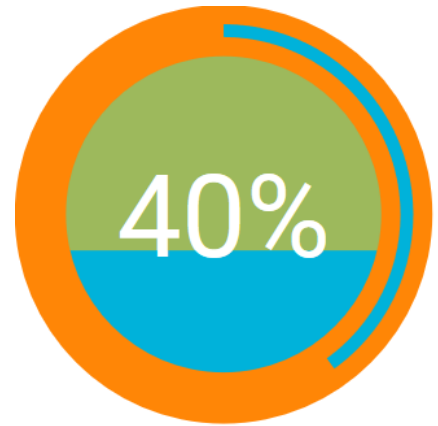
# WEST VIRGINIA OFFICE OF ENERGY SOUTHERN WEST VIRGINIA ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM

The Southern West Virginia Energy Efficiency Program can help small building and business owners by streamlining the process and providing tools and resources needed to overcome obstacles to achieving building energy efficiency. This begins with a free energy assessment, to better identify the goals for your building and business, as well as the paths for achieving those goals. This assessment will:

- Identify low- or no-cost energy savings opportunities
- Benchmark building energy performance
- Conduct an energy audit
- Discuss timing of upgrades and retrofits
- Estimate energy and cost savings potential

Loan funding for energy efficiency upgrade projects will be provided to credit worthy applicants who complete the energy assessment, through the Wyoming County EDA. The business owner will repay the loan through energy savings resulting from energy efficiency improvements.
