



New Carpool Program - Effective September 7, 2021

1. Dismissal times have been adjusted
 - a. **3:20 Grades K-3**
 - b. **3:35 Grades 4-8**
 - c. Preschool remains the same

Carpool will end by 3:55.

2. Families are given number cards colored per dismissal time. Cards will be sent home with the oldest or only. Please look for them in their backpacks. Do not arrive before dismissal time. Come at the dismissal time of your oldest child. It is important that your family/carpool assists to ensure our program runs properly and decrease the traffic back-up in the neighborhood. Cars that arrive before their assigned arrival time block the traffic lanes for younger students and cause delays for everyone.

3. Carpool lines remain the same
 - A-L Enter off of Walnut Hill
 - M-Z Enter of Midway
 - Preschool remains the same

4. Numbers on the colored cards are for each of your children. Please put the card on your dashboard. **We need each of those numbers to plug into the system.**

5. Children will be in their classrooms waiting for their number on the screen and will be dismissed to the appropriate area.

6. Need additional cards: If you need any additional carpool signs or replacements, please email ddikun@stmonicaschool.org and she will notify you when they are ready to pick up at the front desk in McManus Hall. Students with 2 households will receive a card for each household

7. Walker forms will be available on the website week of September 13th under the Parents tab. These are true walkers who live within a 2-mile radius of the school. The walker protocols are different than they have been pre-COVID. This is not for children walking across the street to the park to be picked up. The address on the walker form must match the address on your enrollment tab in FACTS and be within the determined distance from the school. Students will not be dismissed as walkers until they have been given approval.

8. Bike racks will be installed in September. Once these are there will be a form for those who will ride their bikes to school in the morning and leave in the afternoon.
