

The Iowa Assessments (IA) and the CogAT Ability Tests will be administered to all students at St. Monica in grades 1-8 from Monday through Friday, October 10-14. During these five days, quiet time will be observed throughout the campus from 8:00 AM - 10:30 AM. No visitors will be allowed in the building or classrooms during these hours.

It is very important that all students are present and punctual during testing. **Therefore, we ask that all students arrive at school by 7:45 AM during these five days.** Testing will begin promptly at 8:05 AM each day.

Please do not make plans to check your children out of school during the morning testing hours. If it is necessary to schedule doctor/dental appointments, please do so in the afternoon.

There are two things you can do to help your child do their best on the IA. Make sure they get plenty of sleep each night. Enjoy a nutritious breakfast each morning, high in protein, and low in sugar and carbs is recommended.

Tests should be processed and returned to us in November. We will share these results with you once we receive them.
