



Champion Center Spectator Guide: July 1st-2nd

All admission will be pre-sale. There will be no walk-up admission sales. Spectators will need to work with their club to obtain a wristband in order to gain admittance into the facility.

- Following CDC Guidelines, Spectators shall not enter the Community First Champion Center if they have any of the following symptoms:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fever
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Vomiting
 - Diarrhea
 - Runny or Stuffy Nose (not associated with seasonal allergies)
- Spectators are ***Strongly Encouraged to wear a mask***
- Spectator Limits
 - 10 Per Team
- Due to capacity restrictions, Spectators will need to leave the facility after every game
- All Spectators can enter/exit through the Main Entrance in the front parking lot. Spectators will not be allowed in until the facility has been cleared from the previous game.
- Spectators are restricted to the Main Level of the Champion Center. Spectators are not allowed on the playing surface. Any Spectators that do not stay on the Main Level will be removed from the facility with no re-entry.
- Wristbands must be worn.
