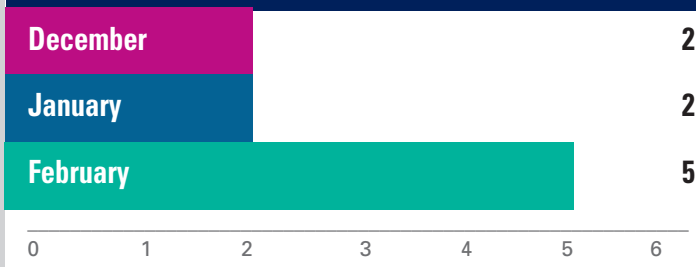

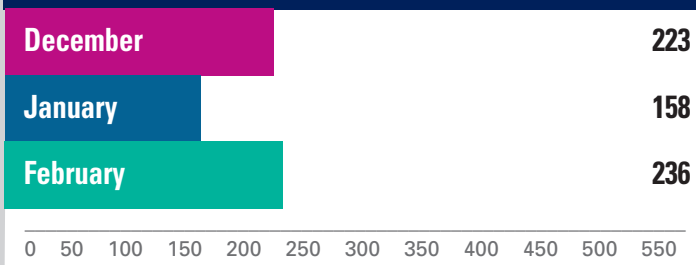

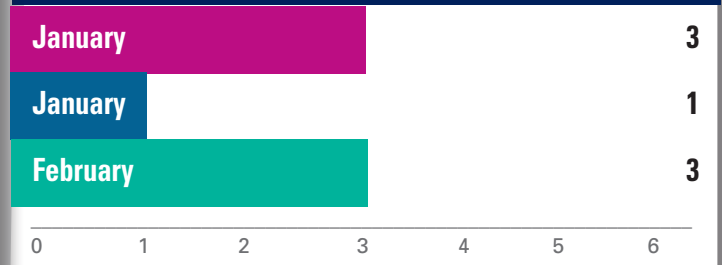

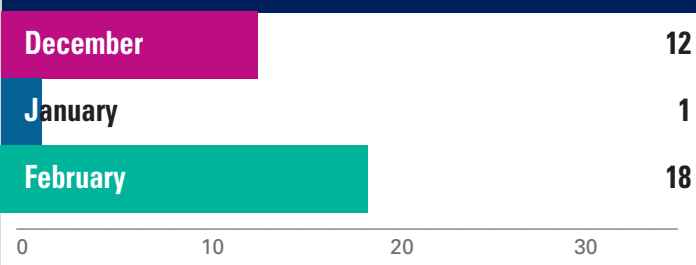

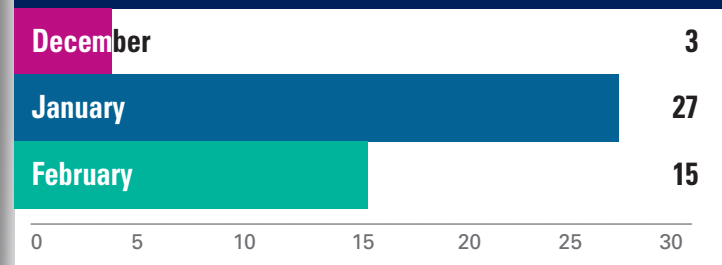

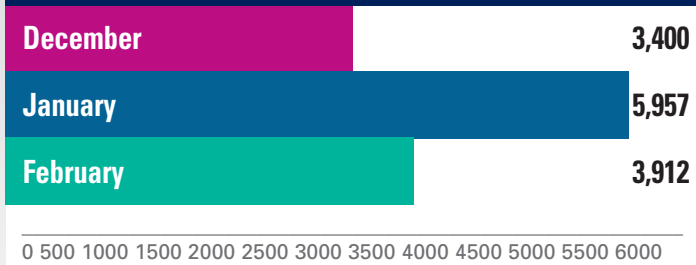

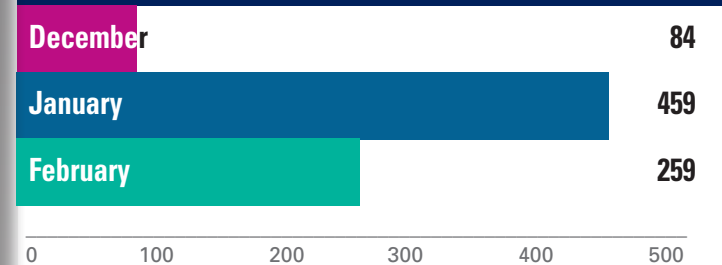
SNOW FALL (INCHES)
