



CIT INTERNATIONAL CIT COORDINATOR CERTIFICATION COURSE

THE COURSE

CIT International now offers a certification course for CIT Coordinators throughout the world. With the understanding that CIT Coordinators are instrumental in the development of partnerships and the creation of effective programs, CIT provides instruction on best practice methods.

Current CIT Coordinators, and those who plan to become coordinators, will receive instruction regarding:

- *CIT Core Elements*
- *Overview of the levels of CIT coordination and the coordinators' roles*
- *A macro-level perspective of a CIT Program*
- *Development and sustaining of a CIT community steering committee*
- *How to maintain a continuous working relationship with all community partners*
- *The importance and engagement of law enforcement leadership*
- *Crisis response system development*
- *Providing leadership for CIT Patrol Officers*
- *The responsibility of maintaining fidelity to the CIT Academy and continuing in-service training*
- *Importance of monitoring commitment laws and transportation policies*
- *Monitoring Federal, State, County, and local issues that may affect community crisis services*
- *Maintaining familiarity with grant requirements*
- *Data collection and outcome measures*
- *Maintaining CIT interests through various communication methods*
- *Assisting other communities with development or enhancement of their CIT programs*

Certificates of completion of this certified course will be provided, as well as a portfolio for notes and a USB drive with supporting documentation for CIT program use.

THE INSTRUCTORS

The instructors are comprised of current and past Directors of the Board of CIT International. All have experience and expertise in the development, as well as sustaining, of CIT programs. Each will share their experiences while reinforcing the philosophies of the best practice CIT Memphis Model.

THE FEE

CIT International will provide this certification course within the Continental United States for a fee of \$300 per attendee. There is a minimum requirement of 50 attendees for a community to host this course.

For those communities that are unable to meet the minimum requirement, CIT International provides the same CIT Coordinator Certification Course in conjunction with its annual CIT Conference. Individuals registered to attend the conference will be able to register to attend the course, at a discounted tuition, to be conducted the day prior to the conference.
