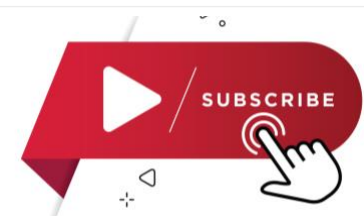


What's New For February 2026

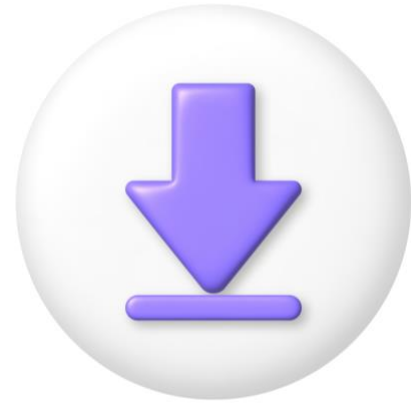
FORMING TRUE PARTNERSHIPS
