The Nominating Committee for the Intergroup Board

Who: The Nominating Committee for Intergroup Board of Trustees is comprised of 3 members (1 outgoing member of the Board and 2 Intergroup Delegates). Delegates are elected by their Home Group's to serve as and Intergroup delegate.

What: The purpose of the Nominating Committee is to help willing A.A. members learn about the service opportunities as a member of Intergroup's Board. *The Nominating Committee is looking for at least six A.A. members willing to stand for election to Intergroup's Board of Trustees.*

Recognizing that Intergroup is budgeted around a half million dollars a year including the bookstore, the Board requires a mix of people with a variety of backgrounds. Both business (financial, marketing, retail sales, and cyber infrastructure) and A.A. service structure backgrounds are needed as is a good knowledge of our Traditions.

The Nominating Committee helps connect A.A. members with this service opportunity.

When: 1 year service commitment (January 1 – December 31)

Where: Houston and the surrounding areas.

Why: Service matters! *Intergroup exists to aid the groups in carrying the A.A. message to the alcoholic who still suffers.* The Trustees that serve on its Board act as the trusted servants who maintain Intergroup's financial standing, adherence to Traditions, and fulfill our mission to carry the message to those outside of the Fellowship.
