Requirements for registration:

All new students are encouraged to know the basic rules and moves *before attending class*. This basic knowledge is available at no charge on our website and our 'practice site' (Chess.com). **Students who have not yet learned these basics may not be fully involved until they have done so.**

C&O Family Chess Center offers unique programs aimed at nurturing a love of the game of chess and offering students and families the means to develop their skills to the highest levels. **Parents are as essential as coaches by encouraging students to practice regularly on Chess.com and come to class on time and prepared.** We will create a free 'Chess.com' account for each new student when they are ready. Parents must 'activate' the account using their club-contact E-mail once it has been created. This 'between classes' portion of the club is essential for the full benefit of our program. Parents may save on tuition by registering in advance or for the entire year (three sessions). Contact the center if you need assistance or have questions.

Snow Days and Absences

C&O Family Chess Center follows the MCPS policy for snow days and other such closings. If MCPS opens late our morning programs are cancelled. If they close early our afternoon programs are cancelled. Under such circumstances students are encouraged to go online with their Chess.com accounts and practice with other students. Coaches may be online, as well, for questions and other chess chat. The same opportunities are often available on scheduled school closing days and holidays. Absences due to weather or illness may be made up at the Saturday Morning Chess Club in Lakeforest Mall.
