May 24, Day 1: Depart the USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare (ORD), or your selected gateway, on an overnight transatlantic flight to Edinburgh. Rest onboard as the pilgrimage begins.

Overnight Flight**May 25, Day 2: Edinburgh | Welcome & Holy**

Beginnings: Meet your guide and enjoy a scenic orientation drive. Celebrate Mass at St. Mary's Catholic Cathedral, visit St. Margaret's Chapel within Edinburgh Castle, then gather for a welcome dinner.

Overnight: Edinburgh (Dinner Included)**May 26, Day 3: Pilgrimage to Lindisfarne, England |**

The Cradle of Celtic Christianity: Travel south across the border to Holy Island, with the causeway crossing timed to the tides. Visit Lindisfarne Priory and reflect on Saints Aidan, Cuthbert and Hilda. Walk to St. Cuthbert's Island and celebrate an outdoor Mass if conditions and permissions allow. Return to Edinburgh this evening. If tides or weather prevent access, an alternate prayer and Mass program will take place in Edinburgh.

Overnight: Edinburgh (Breakfast, Dinner)

May 27, Day 4: Carfin Grotto & Glasgow: Visit Carfin Grotto, Scotland's National Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes, for a guided visit, Mass, the Rosary and Stations of the Cross. Continue to Glasgow for a panoramic city tour.

Overnight: Glasgow (Breakfast & Dinner)

May 28, Day 5: Glasgow to Oban | St. Columba: Journey through the Scottish Highlands to Oban, gateway to the Hebrides. Visit St. Columba's Cathedral and celebrate Mass, subject to scheduling, with time to enjoy the harbor and town.

Overnight: Oban (Breakfast & Dinner)**May 29, Day 6: Pilgrimage to Iona | Sacred Island of the Celts**

Take the ferry from Oban to the Isle of Mull, travel by coach across Mull to Fionnphort, then take the passenger ferry to Iona. Visit Iona Abbey and its sacred grounds, celebrate Mass subject to availability, and enjoy time for prayer and reflection. Return by ferry to Mull, cross the island by coach, and take the ferry back to Oban.

Overnight: Oban (Breakfast & Dinner)**May 30, Day 7: Travel South through Scotland**

Begin with prayer and reflection, then journey south through Scotland's changing landscapes toward the Cairnryan ferry-port region.

Overnight: Southwest Scotland (Breakfast & Dinner)**May 31, Day 8: Ferry to Ireland | Belfast to Dublin:**

Transfer to Cairnryan and cross by ferry to Belfast. Continue south through Northern Ireland and into the Republic of Ireland, traveling through the countryside to Dublin, with Mass celebrated en route or upon arrival.

June 1, Day 9: Kildare & Glendalough | St. Brigid & St. Kevin

Visit the sacred sites of Kildare and reflect on St. Brigid's monastic legacy. Continue to Glendalough for a guided walk among its ancient ruins, lakes and prayerful spaces before returning to Dublin.

Overnight: Dublin (Breakfast & Dinner Included)

June 2, Day 10: Knock Shrine & West of Ireland:

Journey to Knock, Ireland's National Marian Shrine. Visit the Apparition Chapel, Basilica and shrine grounds, celebrate Mass, then continue to Galway.

Overnight: Galway (Breakfast & Dinner).

June 3, Day 11: Connemara, Kylemore Abbey & Cliffs of Moher: Travel through Connemara to Kylemore Abbey, its Benedictine monastery and Gothic chapel. Celebrate Mass at Kylemore Abbey or Galway Cathedral, continue to the Cliffs of Moher, then return to Dublin for a farewell dinner. **Overnight: Dublin (Breakfast & Dinner).**

June 4, Day 12: Return to USA: Transfer to Dublin Airport for your return flight to the United States, carrying home the prayer, fellowship and memories of the pilgrimage. **Meals. Breakfast**

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

A \$500 deposit per person is required at the time of registration, together with a signed registration form. A second payment of \$1,500 per person is due November 25, 2026 (180 days before departure). The remaining balance is due January 24, 2027 (120 days before departure). Reservations are subject to availability and are not confirmed until payment and the required documents are received.

CANCELLATION BY TRAVELER

Land Only: All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation charges per person are: through November 25, 2026 (180 days or more before departure), a minimum \$350 fee; November 25–January 23, 2027 (180–121 days), \$350 plus 50% of the package price; January 24–onward (120 days or fewer before departure), 100% of the package price. Non-refundable supplier charges may also apply. Travel protection is strongly recommended.

Airfare: All cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellation charges per person are: through November 25, 2026 (180 days or more before departure), a minimum \$150 fee; November 25–January 23, 2027 (180–121 days), \$500 minimum cancellation fee; January 24–onward (120 days or fewer before departure), 100% of the airfare price. Non-refundable supplier charges may also apply. Travel protection is strongly recommended.

TRAVEL PROTECTION

If you choose to purchase travel protection, review the plan carefully and purchase it within the time-sensitive period required for any pre-existing-condition waiver or other benefits. Coverage is subject to the policy's terms, conditions, limitations and exclusions. Kingdom Tours is not the insurer and cannot determine coverage.

TIPPING

The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities for guides, drivers, hotel staff or other service providers unless specifically stated in writing.

AIRLINE TICKETS

Airline schedules and fares are subject to change until ticketed. Passenger names must match government-issued travel documents. Name and flight details must be reviewed within 30 days of receipt of registration materials. Once issued, airline tickets may be non-refundable and non-changeable. Any airline penalties, fare differences, seat fees or baggage charges are the traveler's responsibility unless specifically included.

PRICES

The land-only price is \$4,969 per person, based on 25 people minimum, double occupancy, current supplier costs, taxes and exchange rates. The price may be adjusted if fares change, including increases in fuel surcharges; if taxes, currency exchange rates or supplier charges increase; if the group does not reach the minimum required enrollment; or if the itinerary changes for reasons beyond Kingdom Tours' control. Any adjustment will be communicated before final payment whenever reasonably possible. Airfare is quoted separately and is not guaranteed until ticketed.
