This is the season of giving. As we close out the year, the Aubrey Foundation reflects on all of the community events that we were able to contribute to as our way of giving back to the community of North Brunswick; our biggest supporters.

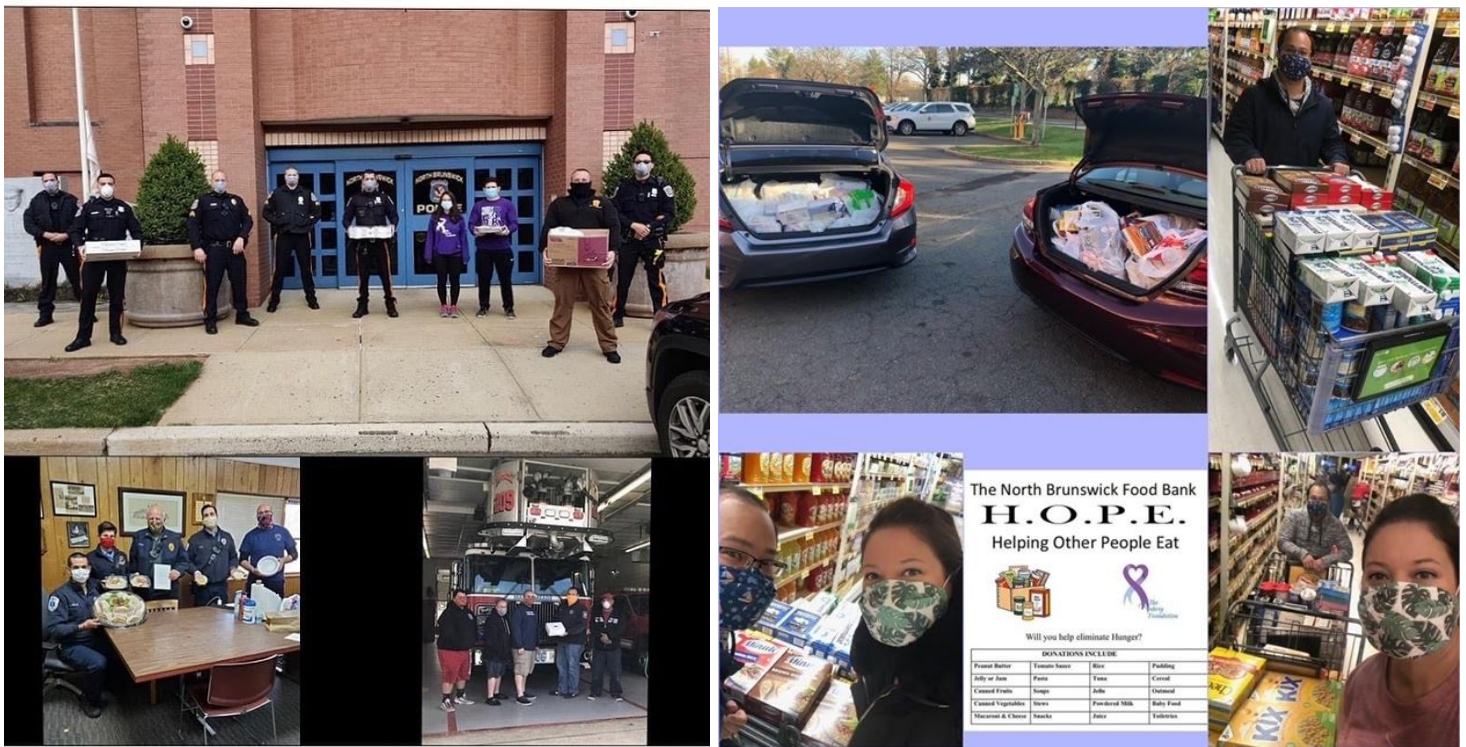
- **Scholarship 2020-** This year we were able to award 5 high school seniors \$1500 each in scholarship money. This was the first year that we were able to increase our gifting from \$5000 to \$7500. We are very fortunate that The Aubrey Foundation was able to increase our scholarship giving.



- **The Pappas Club-** We were able to fund the Pappas Club at Linwood Middle School for the 3rd year. This club allows students to continue to “Live like Aubrey” and give back to the school and community. The Club was moved to the new North Brunswick Middle School this year under the direction of Mrs. Megan Carroll. The club is offered to both 7th and 8th graders at this time.
- **Wreaths Across America -** The Aubrey Foundation donated 36 wreaths to help the We Remember Committee place a wreath for every Veteran’s gravesite at the Elmwood Cemetery on 12/19/20.. That is a donation of \$540! This is the 3rd year in a row that The Aubrey Foundation has been able to support this community event. We were able to help the We Remember Committee meet 100% of their goal.



- **Other Giving** - This year the foundation focused on giving back to the North Brunswick community in Conjunction with our web based platform; Network for Good. Network for Good works in conjunction with our website to help raise money for our giving initiatives.
 - In March we donated \$650 to the North Brunswick Food Bank to help purchase food and supplies.
 - \$100 donation to the CKO Stay in Fight Campaign in support of our local sponsor.
 - First Aid Supplies- \$300 given to purchase supplies and PPE.
 - Feeding the First Responders- North Brunswick PD, FD, and First Aid Squad were all sent food from The Aubrey Foundation as a thank you for their service to the North Brunswick Community during the pandemic.
 - North Brunswick Food Bank- H.O.P.E. for the holidays-over \$1000 in groceries were purchased for the Thanksgiving and the December Holiday Season. We are so grateful to continue our Covid giving initiative by helping the community's food bank.
