The first blessing:

ברוך אתה יי' אלהינו מלך העולם, אשר קידשנו במצוותיו, וציוונו להדליק נר של חנוכה  
(Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech ha'olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tsivanu l'hadlik ner shel Hanukkah.)

Translation: Praised are You, Our God, Ruler of the universe, Who made us holy through Your commandments, and commanded us to kindle the Hanukah lights.

The Second Blessing:

ברוך אתה יי' אלהינו מלך העולם, שעשה נסים לאבותינו, בימים ההם בזמן זהה.  
(Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech ha'olam, she-asah nisim la'avoteinu bayamim hahem bazman hazeh.)

Translation: Praised are You, Our God, Ruler of the universe, Who performed wondrous deeds for our ancestors in those ancient days at this season.

The Third Blessing:

ברוך אתה יי' אלהינו מלך העולם, שהחיינו, וקיימנו, והגענו לזמן זהה.  
(Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech ha'olam, shehecheyanu, v'kiyimanu, v'higiyahu la'zman hazeh.)

Translation: Praised are You, Our God, Ruler of the universe, Who has given us life and sustained us and enabled us to reach this season.
