CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Thank you for your interest in presenting at our Third Annual Behavioral Health Innovation Summit! We are excited to showcase innovative concepts that impact the behavioral healthcare field in our state and beyond. Successful presentations will highlight the demonstrated outcomes and impact of the process, program or initiative being presented. The intended audience is policy makers, funders and colleagues who may have the ability to expand or replicate innovative programs.

There are two options for presentations:

1. **Full Presentation** – Best suited for programs or initiatives that are past the initial implementation stage and in full operation. The program has yielded data that can be presented to show improved outcomes, cost savings, etc. The presentation is 40 minutes, 35 minutes for content delivery with 5 minutes for Q&A.
 - a. Project/Program Name
 - b. Project Summary
 - What – What is the innovation? What challenge prompted it?
 - Why – Why is this important?
 - Who - Target Population
 - How - Service Model Overview
 - How - Funding
 - So What – Data: outcomes, trends, additional considerations
 - Now What - What is needed to replicate in other areas?
2. **Brief Conceptual Presentation** similar to TED Talk format – Best suited to innovations that are under development or in early implementation. Presentations are 20 minutes, 15 minutes for content delivery and 5 minutes for Q&A
 - a. Project/Program Name
 - b. Project Summary
 - What is the innovation and what challenge prompted the innovative response?
 - Why – Why is this important?
 - Where is the project in terms of development and implementation?
 - What are the outcomes you hope to achieve?
 - Why do you think it will work/are there early positive trends or signs of success?
 - Timeline/where do you go from here/next steps
