Early Childhood Education Program for students ages 3-5 years old 2017-2018 School Year



District 46 will have Early Childhood Education Preschool Program openings for the 2017-2018 school year. This program is available to children ages three to five years old. There are openings in both the morning and afternoon sessions. Each half-day session runs five days per week and the program follows the school calendar. Tuition costs for students will be \$290 per month. Parents are responsible for their child's transportation to and from the preschool program. If interest in this program exceeds capacity, children will be enrolled on a lottery basis.

Children who will be three years old on or before September 1, 2017 are eligible for enrollment. You must be a resident of District 46. This requires providing at least **two** forms of proof - a driver's license and voter's registration card. If you do not have a voter's registration card, then three current utility bills may be substituted for this requirement. Gas, electric and water bills will be accepted, but telephone and cable bills will not be accepted. Families who have recently moved into the District also must provide a house closing statement. Renters will need to provide a signed and dated lease with proof of payment of rent. State law requires an original or certified copy of the birth certificate at the time of registration. (A hospital birth announcement cannot be accepted). A copy of your child's social security card is also needed for registration.
