Engineering Excellence Awards

ACEC OKLAHOMA announces the 2021 Engineering Excellence Awards Program.

The timetable for the Oklahoma Program is:

- ** Friday, November 5, 2021 Deadline for receipt of entries
- ** Judging by a panel of judges selected from business, government, and education leaders in Oklahoma will be conducted prior to Wednesday, November 24th.
- ** The top five winning firms will be notified immediately following the judging to allow the firms to finalize their submissions to the ACEC competition which must be received by ACEC no later than Friday, January 7, 2022.
- ** Thursday, January 27, 2022 Announcement of OKLAHOMA WINNERS at the ACEC OKLAHOMA General Membership Meeting and Awards Dinner with winning Firms and their Clients as Special Guests.

The Awards will be: (1) Grand Oklahoma Conceptor and four (4) Oklahoma Honor Awards. Entries not honored as the Grand Conceptor or Honor Awards will receive a "Finalist" award.

The top five (5) winners (Grand Conceptor and 4 Honor Award) are eligible to be submitted to the AMERI-CAN COUNCIL OF ENGINEERING COMPANIES national EEA Program. Deadline for submission to ACEC's Engineering Excellence Awards program is **Friday**, **January 7**, **2022**.

Judging for the national competition will take place in February, 2020. The ACEC Awards Presentation will be Tuesday, April 2022 in Washington DC at which ALL ENTRIES will be displayed.

CRITERIA FOR ENTRY:

- 1. The Criteria and Requirements from the ACEC Engineering Excellence Awards Program will generally be followed for the Oklahoma Program, as outlined in the ACEC "Call for Entries" bulletin. Call ACEC OKLAHOMA for the ACEC national "Call for Entries" brochure or go to the ACEC website at: https://www.acec.org/awards-programs/engineering-excellence-awards/
- 2. Projects entered in the competition must have been substantially completed and ready for use between **November 1, 2019** and October 31, 2021.
- 3. **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS** (Refer to ACEC brochure, "Submission Requirements" for national entry requirements) ACEC OKLAHOMA entries must include the following:
 - * 30" x 30" Display Panel mounted on foam board.
 - * Entry Fee: \$200 for members of ACEC OKLAHOMA; \$500 for non-members, payable to ACEC OKLAHOMA.
 - * One (1) loose-leaf notebook containing: Please note that while ACEC requires ten (10) notebooks, ACEC OKLAHOMA only asks for one (1).
 - * Completed ACEC Entry Form including all required signatures. (SEE NEXT PAGE)

 NOTE Entry Form marked "SAMPLE." PLEASE USE ANYWAY...national has gone to on-line entries, and this is a "Sample" of the online form.

ADDITIONAL NOTE - DO NOT send the entry fee for the ACEC national competition, and DO NOT send anything (entry form, panel, notebook, etc) to ACEC (national) at this time.

- * One (1) Client/Owner Letter as required in Section II, Item 2 of the ACEC Brochure.
- * One (1) Executive Summary as required in Section II, Item 3 of the ACEC Brochure.
- * One (1) Project Description as required in Section II, Item 4 of the ACEC Brochure.
- * Flash Drive containing: 1) Digital copy of the display panel (jpeg format), 2) six different photos or graphics (jpeg), and , 3) Microsoft Word version of Executive Summary and Project Description.

GENERAL

ACEC deadlines are to accommodate the National Awards Presentation to ACEC Annual Convention in Washington, DC. **All State entries** will be displayed and recognized as part of the National Awards event. This will provide significant exposure of your entry, especially to Members of Congress, Agency Officials, as well as International and Washington dignitaries.

Your Display Panel WILL NOT BE RETURNED, however your notebook will be returned immediately following judging, if requested.
