BALLET DEPARTMENT

BOYS: Level-appropriate t-shirt (see color assignments below; black or white t-shirt is also acceptable at all levels) / black shorts or athletic tights / white or black socks / black Ballet shoes / hair secured away from face / no bulky or heavy jewelry

GIRLS: Level-appropriate leotard (see color assignments below) / flesh-toned or pink tights / flesh-toned or pink Ballet slippers / long hair secured in a bun / short or braided hair secured away from face / no bulky or heavy jewelry

PRE-BALLET & KINDER BALLET: LIGHT PINK, no skirts

BALLET 1: WHITE, black alignment belt, no skirts

BASIC BALLET: TEAL, black alignment belt, no skirts

BALLET 1 ACCELERATED: WHITE, black alignment belt, no skirts

BALLET 2A: LAVENDER, black alignment belt, no skirts

BALLET 2B: LIGHT BLUE, black alignment belt, no skirts

BALLET 3A: ROYAL BLUE, black alignment belt, no skirts

BALLET 3B: TURQUOISE, no skirts, Gail Grant's *Technical Manual & Dictionary of Classical Ballet*

BALLET 4: FOREST GREEN, no skirts

BALLET 5: BURGUNDY, short chiffon skirt allowed after barre

BALLET 6: EGGPLANT, short chiffon skirt allowed after barre

BALLET 7: NAVY BLUE, short chiffon skirt allowed after barre

BALLET 8: BLACK, short chiffon skirt allowed after barre

CHARACTER: Level-appropriate leotard/shirt, black Character skirt, black Character shoes

FOOT & ANKLE CONDITIONING: Level-appropriate Ballet uniform, convertible tights

POINTE: Level-appropriate Ballet attire, convertible tights, Ballet slippers with ribbons attached (or teacher-approved Pointe shoes), theraband

JAZZ DEPARTMENT

JR JAZZ & JR LYRICAL: RED LEOTARD/SHIRT, black leggings or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Jazz shoes

SR JAZZ & SR LYRICAL: BLACK LEOTARD/SHIRT, black leggings or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Jazz shoes

LEAPS & TURNS: Solid color leotard, black leggings or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Jazz shoes

BROADWAY DANCE: Solid color leotard, black leggings or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Jazz shoes

MUSICAL THEATRE: Comfortable clothing, close-toed shoes

TAP DEPARTMENT

EARLY CHILDHOOD TAP: LIGHT PINK LEOTARD/SHIRT (black or white t-shirt also acceptable), black biker shorts, black Tap shoes

JR TAP: PURPLE LEOTARD/SHIRT, black shorts or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Tap shoes

SR TAP: BLACK LEOTARD/SHIRT, black shorts or tights (no booty/running shorts), black Tap shoes

HIP-HOP DEPARTMENT

EARLY CHILDHOOD, ELEMENTARY, & JR HIP-HOP: PINK or RED SHIRT, black leggings or pants (no shorts), clean sneakers

SR HIP-HOP: Solid color shirt, black leggings or pants (no shorts), clean sneakers

MODERN DEPARTMENT

ALL LEVELS: Solid color leotard/shirt, black leggings or tights (no shorts), bare feet

ADULT CLASSES

Comfortable/athletic clothing. Form-fitting clothing is encouraged, but not required. Appropriate dance shoes should be worn for class.
