Q: I've reached the age where I have to take an RMD from my retirement account. Can I use it to pay my pledge?

A: Yes, you can – and aren't you a smart cookie for thinking of it! If you have to take a Required Minimum Distribution each year, having a check sent directly to St. Nicholas (instead of to you) can have income tax advantages. Check with your financial advisor to see if your particular circumstances qualify.

**The St. Nicholas Book Club** has chosen *James* by Percival Everett for its December book. Published in 2024, the novel is a re-imagining of *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* by Mark Twain. In it, Huckleberry's friend on his travels, Jim – a fugitive slave –narrates the travels rather than Huck. The novel won the 2024 Kirkus Prize, the National Book Award for Fiction, and the 2025 Pulitzer Prize for Fiction. The Book Club next meets on **December 3 after Evening Prayer.**
