We encourage all not-for-profits, houses of worship, public schools, neighborhood associations, and civic organizations to submit a proposal for program ideas aligned with Healthier Jupiter's mission and goals. Individuals or businesses interested in applying must partner with a registered not-for-profit, civic organization or government agencies. **Interested parties must submit an interest form to be eligible to submit a mini-grant application.**
