- * Attend ALL Training Sessions
- * Valid Driver's License & Vehicle
- * Cell Phone (with Texting)
- * Internet Access
- * GPS Navigation System
- * Three 12-hour Shifts a Month
- * Attend Monthly CE Meetings
- * Complete 3-Month Field Training
- * 1-year Volunteer Contract
