 - b. Scope: Housing, Food Access, Water Distribution, Points of Distribution (PODs)
 - c. Build-Up
 - i. Q3 Shelter Village Tabletop
 - ii. DRC Coordinator Training (Q2 & Q3)
 - iii. ESF #6 Cadre Meeting (Q3 & Q4)
2. Multnomah **County Planning Section, in coordination with the Emergency Support Functions (ESFs)**, will **submit an Initial Damage Assessment (IDA) Report to the Unified Command** by hour 144 following a Cascadia Subduction Zone Earthquake scenario.
 - a. Core Capabilities: Critical Infrastructure
 - b. Scope: Roads & Bridges, County Facilities, Critical Infrastructure/Facilities (healthcare, transportation, utilities, etc.), Municipality Reports,
 - c. Build-Up
 - i. Q2 Damage Assessment Seminar (Plan)
 - ii. Q3 Damage Assessment Workshop (Countywide DA Operations Collation)
 - iii. Q3 Planning Section Cadre Training (Include Damage Assessment Unit)
3. Multnomah **County Planning Section, in coordination with the Emergency Support Functions (ESFs)**, will **submit a Situation Report to the Unified Command** by hour 168 following a Cascadia Subduction Zone Earthquake scenario.
 - a. Core Capabilities: Critical Infrastructure (emergency transportation routes), Operational Coordination.
 - b. Scope: Emergency Transportation Routes (ETRs), Sheltering Actions, Damage Assessment Data, Other ESF Reports.
 - c. Build-Up
 - i. Q2/Q3 Situation Report Workshop (Planning Section Cadre Meeting?)
 - ii. Q4 Situation Report Training (ALL EOC Sections)

4. Multnomah County **Emergency Support Function #12** will **establish, and operate, a Fuel Point of Distribution (FPOD)** by hour 144 following a Cascadia Subduction Zone Earthquake scenario.
 - a. Core Capabilities: Critical Infrastructure
 - b. Scope: ESF #12 Fuel Group Formed, FPOD Established and Operated,
 - c. Build-Up
 - i. Q3 Fuel Plan Seminar
 - ii. Q4 ESF #12 Workshop (Group & FPOD)
5. Multnomah County **Logistics Section** (*objective not determined yet.*)
 - a. Status & tracking resource requests
 - i. Engagement w/ State for: O1, O2, O4
 - ii. Multiple ESF resource requests & sharing updates w/ them
 - b. On-site (& EOC?) logistics support and resource requesting
 - i. Inventory and tracking
 - ii. ESF Logs staff
 - c. Healthcare Requests (Headquarters Model)
